Q&A

1. Do you send out email notifications when new versions / updates are available as I don't seem to get these.

We send all release notifications to the primary contact responsible for Caseware within your firm. If you are unsure who your primary contact is, please contact our Support Team.

2. If we upgrade to the new Working papers 2022, will this impact our statutory accounts disclosures that we currently have? We have tailored most of our accounts with our auditors so when we perform a year-end roll forward would we lose all of these tailored disclosures? We have over 200 accounts so this would a lot of work if we had to redo all the disclosures for 2022 year-ends.

Working Papers is the base platform upon which you install the templates that contain the relevant disclosures (for example, AccountsAdvanced). Updating Working Papers will, therefore, only affect the functionality of the base software and not your engagement files.

After installing an ePack, you will be prompted to apply functionality and disclosure updates to your files (upon opening them). You can choose to apply or dismiss these updates but we recommend always taking functionality updates to ensure that the software continues to perform smoothly.
